- Sunset Motors: Seeking new Class II Car Dealership License: did not submit 2022 renewal
 - Michael Peters present and application sent to LLA in full with payment on 12.28.21 & 1.12.22
 - LLA reviewed why renewal was not sent in timely

- Outdoor Live Entertainment Application policies and procedures (continued from October; and November hearings)
 - Sam Dibble/New City Brewery present with same concerns addressed on 11/9/21 emails
 - Review and deliberations with the LLA
 - Donna Cuipyllo present and speaking in favor of delaying application
 - LLA reviewed this being 3rd public hearing and did not receive any other weigh-in from local licensees in objection
 - LLA Clerk worked with Police, Fire, Building, Planning, and Health Departments in agreeance of application
 - LLA discussed approval of application creation with draft application sent back to liquor licensees and any public requesting it; allowing those individuals 30 days to mark-up with the application for suggested changes and then final application will be sent out to all licensees and posted on the website for access

- Increase in LLA fees final hearing: implementation of increased fees for alcohol and car dealership license to be in-line with other local communities

- LLA Clerk reviewed data collection from 2019/ expressed concerns around how the City likely will not be in-line even if voted on based off of timelines now
- LLA Clerk suggests if the board votes it only be a 10% fee increase
- LLA deliberated and was not comfortable issuing higher fees as the City enters their 3rd year of a pandemic
- LLA Clerk will collect new and current data again and reassess at the November 2022 meeting for implementation in 2024.
