EASTHAMPTON RECEIVES 2,880 RAPID COVID-19 TESTS FROM THE BAKER-POLITO ADMINISTRATION

The Easthampton Health Department has received 2,880 iHealth COVID-19 rapid test kits (two tests/kit) from the Baker-Polito administration. Easthampton residents may receive two test kits/person at the following locations:

All test kits will have a sticker with a QR code that can be scanned to view the accurate expiration date. On March 29, 2022, the FDA granted a **three-month shelf-life extension** for the iHealth COVID-19 rapid tests with an expiration date on or before 9/29/2022.
