Aging-in-Place Program

The City of Easthampton, with assistance from the Pioneer Valley Planning Commission, has grant funding to assist qualified seniors age 65 and over to fund the Easthampton Aging in Place Program. Low- and moderate-income senior homeowners would be eligible to receive a grant of up to \$5,000 and assistance to implement improvements which will allow occupants to remain safely in their homes. Eligible improvements include, but are not limited to safety repairs, grab bars, handrails, non-slip stair treads, smoke and carbon monoxide detectors, door and window locks, removal of code violations and other similar repairs which improve the safety and functionality of one's home.

In addition to being **65 or more years of age** and **residing in the home that you own**, applicants must also **meet the income guidelines according to household size**.
