Compost Bin**



33" tall with a capacity of 11 cubic feet (80 gallons), about four bags of leaves. Features a sliding door near the bottom for removing compost and a rodent resistant twist-lock lid. Made in Canada with 50% post-consumer recycled plastic.

**Great American  
Rain Barrel**



60-gallon rain barrels from repurposed food grade polyethylene shipping drums (UV protected and BPA free). 39" tall by 24" wide diameter and weighs 20 lbs. empty. Comes with lid, insect screen, plastic spigot for hose connection, 2 overflow valves, and drain plug.

**Kitchen Scrap  
Bucket**



A portable compost carrier for short term storage of kitchen compost. Capacity of 1.9 gallons. Micro-perforated lid keeps insects out and reduces odors. Dishwasher safe. Made with a minimum of 30% post-consumer recycled plastic.

**Curbside  
Recycling Bin**



A lightweight and sturdy curbside recycle container. 14 gallon capacity. Durable and functional with easy grip handles. Made of 35% post-consumer recycled plastic.
